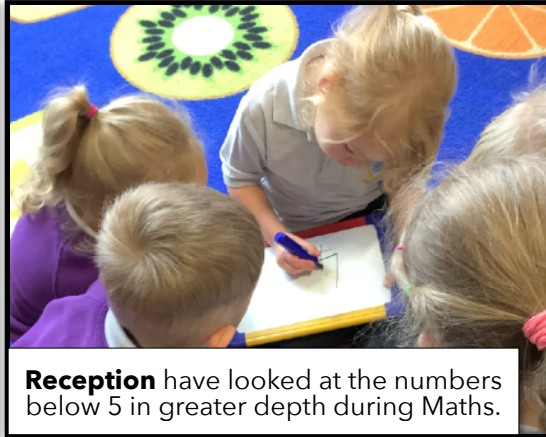

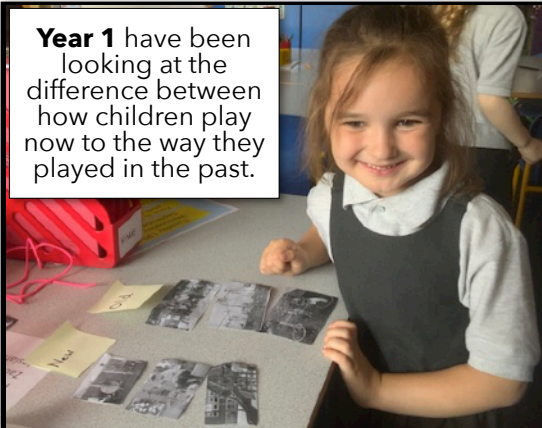

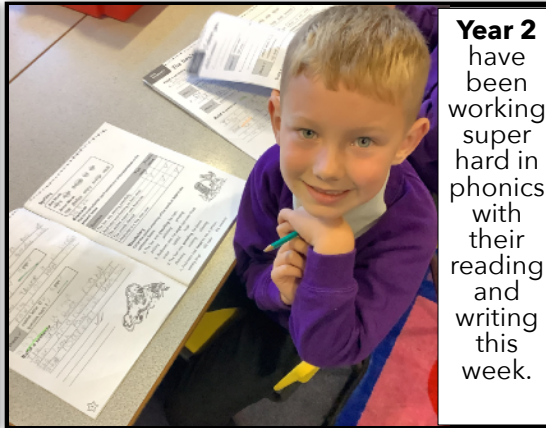
Nursery have made their favourite animals from the story "Dear Zoo".

Spotlight On: **Technology**

At Mile Cross we are proud of the range of technology available to support learning.

Our school uses Apple for the majority of its IT, with iPads available to all classes and our ICT suite is equipped with Apple Macs. However, the software we use, in most cases, is compatible across a range of different systems (including Chrome and Windows) meaning children can access work, software and websites at home just as they would in school.

In terms of software used, children logon to cloud based systems like Showbie, which mirrors and supports the information the teachers are sharing on the front of class interactive whiteboards. Pupils can also access Apps like Spelling Shed and Times Tables Rockstars too.

The main thing for our school is that the technology we use in class has to support learning and not get in the way or be a distraction from that learning.
